

Full Day in Quito (Thursday or Friday)







After breakfast, you will head to the Middle of the World Monument, located in the place marked as the 000'0" latitude by the French Geodesic Mission in the 18th century. Don't miss the picture with your feet on both hemispheres! Then, continue to the Intiñan Museum, a cultural and educational center for cosmic and scientific research on the natural effects of being in the middle of the world, which is located where the GPS only in recent years marked as the 0°0'0"; it's just a few minutes away from the first monument visited. This is a really fun and interactive museum.

For lunch, enjoy a traditional Ecuadorian meal at Santana Brewery. Discover more about the Andean cuisine, within an artisanal brewery and learn about its history and efforts for making a local beer.

After lunch, discover Quito's beautiful Historic Center, named World Heritage Site by the UNESCO. Quito is a city with a rich history, hiding the most fascinating legends, forbidden love stories, political insurrection plans, and more. Learn about the different architecture styles in the Old Town, stroll through cobblestoned streets and meet some artisans who've kept traditions alive for centuries. Touch the sky on top of the La Compañía Church! After the visit to this gold leaf covered church, climb the stairs and visit the cupolas for a fantastic and unique view of the city. This tour will give you a 360° experience of Quito's Historic. Experience an exclusive tasting of the best chocolate in the world, and learn more about Ecuadorian chocolate and the amazing cacao that grows on this side of the world.
